BACHELOR'S AND MASTER'S GRADING SYSTEM

Both Bachelor's and Master's students are graded on the same scale. The below grading system is the new grade value currently applicable at the IICSE University

Credit Transfer

Credits and grade points earned at other Universities are not included in the GPA calculation at IICSE University.

Repeated Courses

Students may repeat courses in which a below than average, or minimum passing grade has been earned, in order to work towards a better grade to assist in raising GPA. If a course is repeated, the higher grades will be used in calculating the cumulative GPA and for completion of program requirements. The original course will remain on the official transcript as credits attempted but not earned.

CALCULATING GPA

To calculate the cumulative grade point average, divide the sum of the quality points by the sum of semester hours.

CLASSIFICATION OF THE DEGREE

BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAMS

The classification for Bachelor Degree is based on the cumulative grade point average at graduation as follows:

3.60 or higher: Summa Cum Laude (First Class Honors)

3.40-3.59: Magna Cum Laude (Second Class Honors, Upper Division)

3.20-3.39: Cum Laude (Second Class Honors, Lower Division)
3.00-3.19: Third Class Honors
2.00-2.99: High Pass
1.50-1.99: Low Pass:
0.00-1.49: Fail

MASTER'S AND DOCTORATE DEGREE PROGRAMS

Both Master's and Doctorate's students are classified on the same scale. The classification for Master's and Doctorate's Degree programs are based on the cumulative grade point average at graduation as follows:

3.60 or higher: Summa Cum Laude (Highest Distinction)

3.40-3.59: Magna Cum Laude (High Distinction)

3.20-3.39: Cum Laude Cum Laude (Distinction)

NON-DEGREE PROGRAMS

Non-degree programs at IICSE University are classified as Distinction, Pass (P) or Fail (F).

3.60 or higher: Distinction

1.50-3.59: Pass

0-49: Fail
